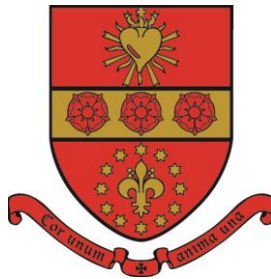


St. Francis' College



Regulation Uniform List for Senior School pupils (Years 7-11)

All girls, both Boarding and Day are requested to have the following items of clothing:

Winter

Kilt in "Stuart Hunting" Tartan - length should be no more than 10cm above knee

White blouses with reverse collar

Green V-neck jumper with red trim and College badge

Navy blue blazer with College badge

Navy College jacket or plain black or navy coat

Navy socks or navy opaque tights

Black shoes – sensible school shoes – no heels more than 2.5cm (leather only)

Summer

White short sleeved blouse with reverse collar

Navy sleeveless jumper with green trim (optional)

White socks – ankle length

Additional regulations

Jewellery: Small plain gold or silver stud earrings (one per earlobe)

Watch

Jewellery worn by pupils for religious reasons is acceptable

Hair

All students are expected to have clean and tidy hair.

For Health & Safety reasons hair must be tied up for: Science, PE, Food and Nutrition, and when directed to by a member of staff.

Extreme cuts and styles are unacceptable, as is ill-kempt hair.

Unnatural colours are not acceptable.

Gloves/scarves/hats in a plain dark colour are acceptable.

Hockey Mouth guard – Mouth guards can be made by your family dentist or a mouldable mouthguard can be purchased from good sports shops or from an online supplier such as Opro. **Girls must wear their mouth guard and shin pads whilst playing hockey.**

It is important that girls should present a good image at all times, particularly when in uniform. In the **Autumn and Spring Terms** all girls must wear **full winter uniform** to and from College and no girls should go out in part uniform (a mixture of school uniform and mufti). In the **Summer Term** girls are expected to wear the **full summer uniform** to and from College unless permission is given to do otherwise because of weather conditions.

Other Items:

PVC apron for Food and Nutrition lessons

Year 9-11 only. Lab coat for science (100% cotton) – available from John Lewis or other online retailers.

Schoolblazer

- Schoolblazer are an online retailer – allowing parents to order anytime and from anywhere at their convenience. If you do not have internet access Schoolblazer can take telephone orders on 0333 7000 703.
- All garments arrive fully name-tagged, at no extra charge, eliminating this annual summer chore.
- Schoolblazer build a bespoke site for the College; allowing simple navigation to the correct uniform and sportswear for your daughter, there is also the option to select a “freshers pack” which has everything a new pupil requires.
- Uniform is delivered via courier service, either to the home or to an address of your choice, with a normal turn-around of 4 to 5 days for name-tagged garments, but a firm promise of all deliveries within 8 working days. Urgent garments which do not require name-tagging can be shipped in 2 days.

- The web-site has an “intelligent sizing system” to ensure that garments fit first time, but if they do not the returns process is designed to be trouble-free.
- Sample sizes will be held in the College.
